MILE HIGH MENS GOLF CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Adopted Feb. 2019

MHMGC members are expected to act in a manner that reflects true sportsmanship and maintains the integrity of the game.

DO NOT

- Cause the destruction of any golf course property.
- Throw or slam golf clubs in anger.
- Have any physical contact or verbally abuse any competitor/opponent.
- Use excessive foul language.
- Intentionally violate any of the rules of golf.
- Use your cell phone during tournament play that delays the pace of play.
- Fall behind the pace of play expectations.

For the purposes of correcting poor behavior the MHMGC Tournament Committee reserves the right to assess a two stroke penalty to any member that breaches the "Code of Conduct". For offenses deemed extreme by the committee, disqualification from the tournament may be warranted.

If assessed disqualification by breach of our "Code of Conduct", the member has the right to appeal at the **next** MHMGC board meeting. The member must notify the Board President that he intends to appeal 48 hours prior to the meeting.
