Welcome to the Golf Handicap Program at MHMGC. We hope you will enjoy the golf program and be an active participant in club tournaments.

As required by the USGA, the Handicap Committee at MHMGC undertakes activities to ensure that all members understand the USGA Handicap System and that all scores are posted. The MHMGC has adopted and is enforcing a club rule that all scores must be posted no later than midnight, the day of play. Certain exceptions apply. Failure to post as required will result in a "P" score (penalty) which is posted by the committee. The rules of golf do not require the committee to notify you of such a posting. MHMGC strictly enforces the posting of scores. This ensures a level playing field for all members not only for our club but for any outside events our members may wish to participate in.

If for any reason you are unable to post a score the day played contact a member of the handicap committee as soon as possible. The committee at its discretion will determine if the score can be posted at a later date or if a P score is merited. Texting, email or phone calls are acceptable and encouraged.

For golfers without a handicap, you will be required to post five scores to receive a valid USGA Handicap Index. For golfers with an existing handicap, please give your scoring records from your previous club to the MHMGC Handicap Committee so that they can be posted.
